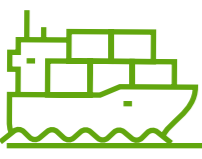


TROPICAL AND EXOTIC FRUITS

Benefits



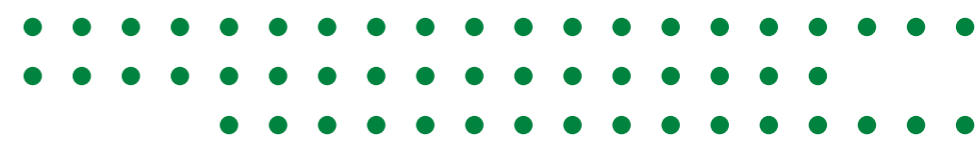
Besides being sweet, pineapple is abundant in potassium, iodine and vitamins A, B and C. It contains 85% of water.



Watermelon is the fruit that contains the greatest amount of water, with 93% in its composition, therefore its caloric value is only 20 calories per 100 grams. Helps to reduce conditions such as asthma, cancer and inflammation.



These products have excellent nutritional and medicinal properties, for example, cape gooseberry has a high content of vitamin A and antioxidants, soursop has anti-cancer characteristics, or ipecac, which is used in medicine for the treatment of conditions in the respiratory tract.
